BROKEN ARM IN LAST TILT DECIDES WIN

Salerno Gets Default In 175-Pound Class Against Russell

Edison-Tech High School gained its tenth wrestling championship in 11 years under Coach Hobert Hoff by defeating West High School yesterday afternoon at Tech after a thrilling meet, 15½ to 11½, in the final Interscholastic League contest, of the season for both teams. The Occidentals and Inventors were tied for the loop leadership with one loss apiece until yesterday. West defeated Edison-Tech in their first encounter, 19 to 9.

The meet was decided in the last bout when Everett Russell, West rider, was forced to default the match to Joe Salerno because of an injury to his right arm. The default meant five points and the winning margin for the Inventors. Russell was taken to the Municipal Hospital in an ambulance, where x-ray disclosed a fractured arm. Salerno competed in the 160-pound section in the city interscholastic meet last week.

East and Monroe Meet

George Rice of the Inventors and Michael Caputo put up the best match of the afternoon in the 118-pound division. Rice revenged the loss he received in their initial encounter by amassing the edge of 3 minutes, 3 seconds after some hard and fast grappling.

East and Monroe highs will close their loop seasons this afternoon meeting at Monroe at 3:30 o'clock.
