

# WRESTLING IN SCHOOLS DRAWS CUT

Scholastic wrestling will be discontinued beginning next week for the balance of the school year according to an announcement made yesterday by Herman J. Norton, director of health education. Lack of finances because of the drastically cut school budget, was given as the reason.

The elimination of the sport is figured to save the Board of Education a sum of \$600. Six schools had teams entered in the Inter-scholastic Wrestling League. They were Edison-Tech, West High, Benjamin Franklin, East High, Monroe and Charlotte. The schedule of this league, of course, will be abandoned and the teams broken up.
