

ELIMINATE 10 IN MAT EVENT

Ten hopeful wrestlers went to the showers last night at the Columbus Club gym, four by the far route, as the Monroe County amateur grappling championships got under way. Finals are scheduled for tomorrow night.

The feature match bracketed Howie Reynolds, Columbus Club team captain, and Dick Baumann, Mechanics Institute star who has just returned from the Lehigh intercollegiate meet. Baumann, wrestling for the Central Y, lost when injuries forced him to retire. He would not quit, however, until the bout was stopped. Up to that time the agile Reynolds was well out in front and punishing Baumann particularly with leg holds.

One of the quickest falls was gained by Hanna of the Columbians, who tossed Skajky of the Aljo Club after 28 seconds. It was in this class, 155 pounds, that most of the grappling was concentrated.

Other falls went to Jimmy Cavoti, Columbus Club, who threw Downey, a club-mate, in less than two minutes; Steve Bailey, Central Y, whose victim was Patterson of the Aljos, and George Houle, Edison-Tech, who pinned young Pat Cavoti of the Columbians.

Second longest, most grueling collision of the evening saw Burnett of the Columbus Club receive a time advantage over Joe Arlouchka, Central Y, after 1:45 minutes of an over-time period. The pair met last week in an inter-club match, Burnett also winning at that time.

Of the 32 entries, Art Bott, Cerami, Sommers, Rickless and Whitty of the Aljos; D'Ambrosia of the Columbus Club, and Bulavnets of Central Y automatically go into tomorrow night's finals. Bulavnets, Y team captain, meets Dom Scherzi in what should be an outstanding bout. Jerry Deprey and Milner, both Columbus Club, also advanced via the bye route.
