Gerald Monahan Wins 120 Lb. Wrestling Title at Rochester; Drum, A-A, Takes 112

In a somewhat bollixed up situation last Friday and Saturday at Rochester, in which Class A-A schools elected to wrestle Class B schools, Allegany county matmen didn't fare too well. Gerald Monahan of BCS, who was eliminated in the county finals on a referee's decision, was entered in the Class B competition and won the Section V crown from Oosterman of Spencerport. Glenn Drum, in the 112 pound class, won the title in Class B competition. He is from Alfred-Almond.

Joe Codispoti, who also was put out of the county Class B tourney, was also entered in Class A, and lost in the finals to Tascione of Madison High School, Rochester, on decision.

Other finalists in Class A were Stebbins in the 133 pound division; Dally, 145, and Brown, 165, all of Wellsville. All were defeated.

Finalists in Class B were Austin, 97; Sturdevant, 120, and Morrison, unlimited, all of Wellsville, who were defeated.

In the preliminaries, held Friday afternoon, W. Monahan, 103, won by a pin over Bell of Holley. Carl Monahan, 127, won a pin over Petota, Holley; Merle Crandall, 133, decisioned ColHags, Spencerport; Brad Hall, 145, lost on decision to

Chlenzo of Geneva, last year's Section champ; Russ Lewis, 154, won on a forfeit and Wayne Torrey lost on decision to Ottman of Geneva.

In the Class B semi-finals W. Monahan lost on decision to Civilet, Geneva; C. Monahan lost on decision to Morroco of Geneva; Crandall lost to Fetteroit, Geneva, on decision, and Lewis lost by decision to Paone of Geneva.

Class A semi-finalists were G. Monahan, who decisioned DiPorzio, Jefferson High School of Rochester, and Joe Codispoti decisioned Brongo, Spencerport. Geneva was the team winner.

Coach Dutch Dunning said there may be one more match this season, a return bout with Jasper there.
