The future of the Saxon wrestling team shows prospects of being bright as no member of the squad will be lost through graduation.

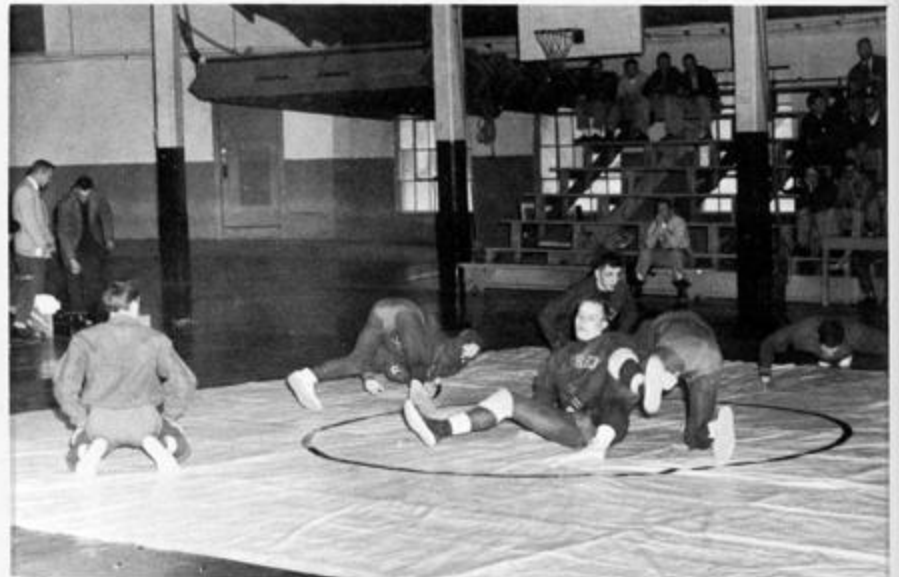
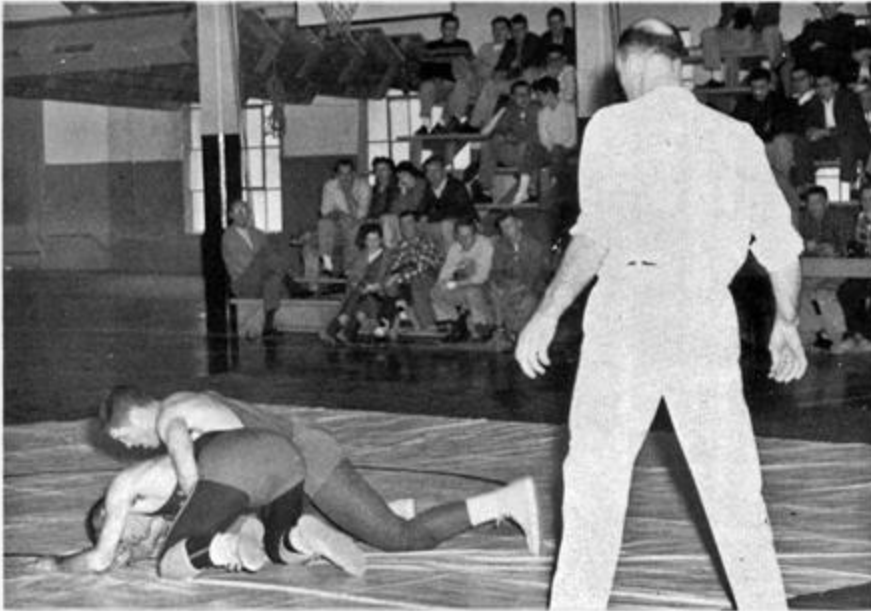
Although Coach Yunevich's club had a poor 1-6 campaign, the squad, composed of sophomores and juniors, with a few freshmen gave outstanding performances in spots to give hopes of a victorious season.

Leading the squad was John "Frenchy" LeBlanc and freshman, Ron Carmichael, who had identical 5-2 records, while Dick Errico turned in a 3-2 campaign, despite a dislocated shoulder in the opening match against Cortland State.

Steve Sperber and Al Bush just missed winning campaigns as they turned in 3-4 marks. The quintet of LeBlanc, Carmichael, Errico, Bush and Sperber all received their varsity letters for the campaign, while freshman, Larry Wander, received a frosh numeral. The lone victory was a 16-14 win over the top-flight Rochester Institute of Technology squad in the Men's Gym when Dick Errico turned in a pin in the heavyweight class to turn a 14-11 deficit into a 16-14 triumph.

Others gaining decisions in this match were Ron Carmichael and Larry Wander at 157 and 167 pounds and Andy Seaman with a forfeit at 137. This set the stage for Errico's win and the match.

Both LeBlanc and Carmichael represented the University at the Case Invitational Tournament in Cleveland.
