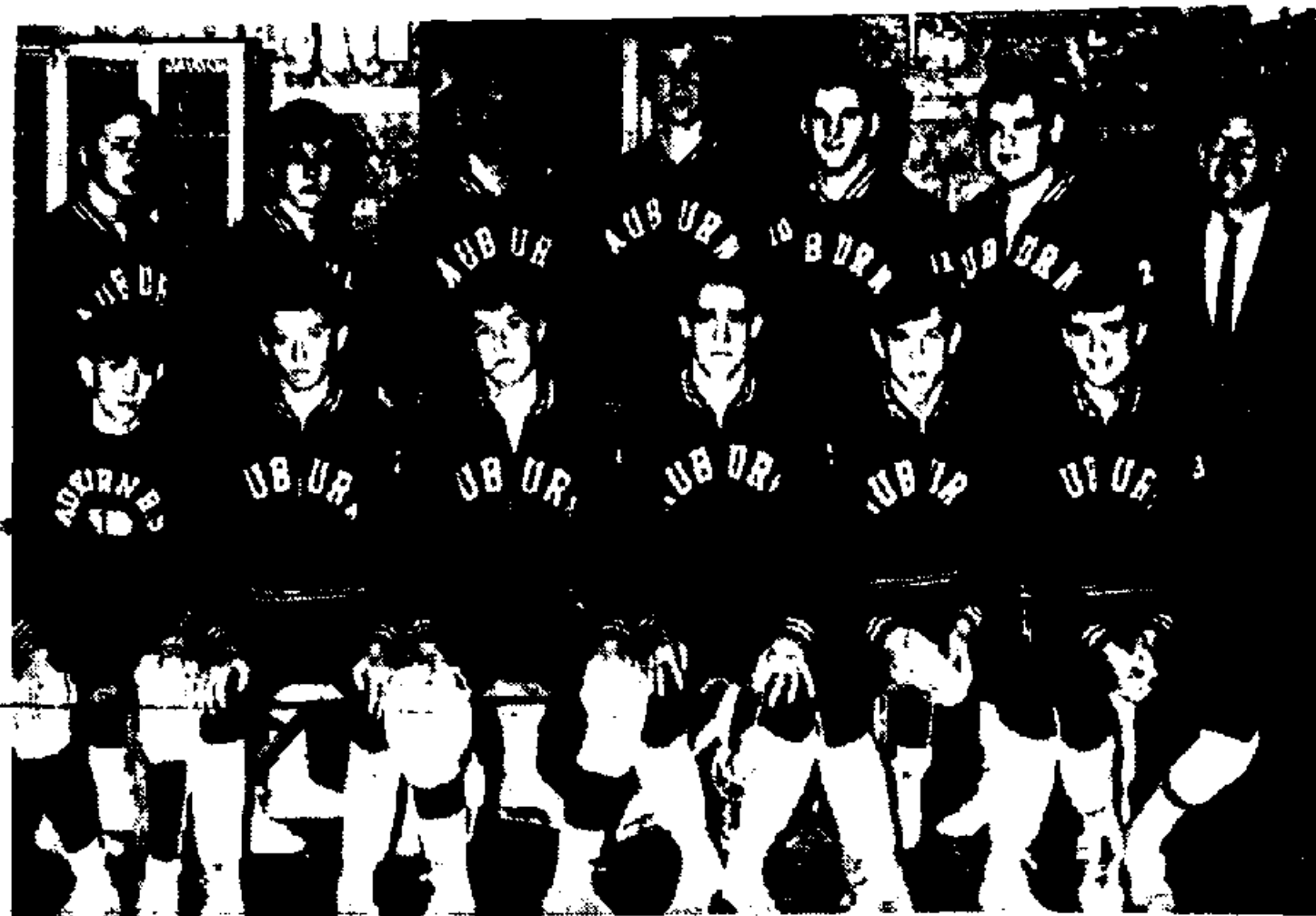
The Maroon mermen under coach Pat Ferguson will compete in the Colgate Relays at Hamilton on Tuesday. The program starts at 10 a.m.
