# Edison Wrestlers Sweep City Championship Meet

Edison Tech easily won the 21st annual City Wrestling Tournament Championship last night at East High, outscoring its nearest rivals by 37 points. Coach Frank Mielnicki's matmen totaled 92 points to 55 for both East and Jefferson which tied for runnerup honors. Madison was fourth with 50 and Marshall and Monroe tied for fifth with 45.

Nine champions, including two defending champs, finished their city league season undefeated. The Pizzo brothers of Edison, Ralph at 168 and Casper, a defending champ in the heavyweight division, both went 11-0 as did Madison's Bob Rosier at 157.

Defending champion Sam Dade of Madison at 115, Charlotte's Carm Oliveri at 106 and Monroe's Tom Whitaker at 130 racked up 10-0 records.

Edison's Doug Rhodes at 141, East's Ernie Smith at 98 and West's Mike Robinson at 148 finished unbeaten with nine, eight and six wins, respectively.

Upset of the night was the defeat of defending champion Lou Masi of Jeff in the 141 class. Masi had won 27 straight city league matches before losing to Rhodes, 5-3, in the finals.

The winners will represent the city league in tomorrow's Section 5 tournament at East Rochester High.

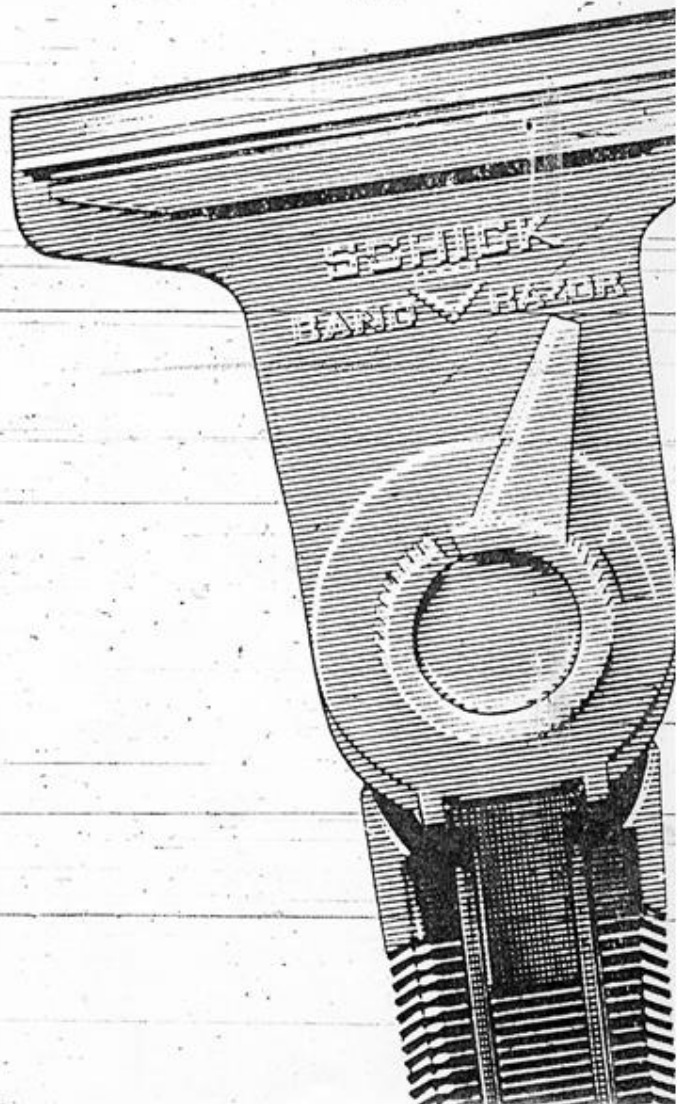
