

# *Two CCT Champs at Mat Tourney*

The Clarkson College wrestling team captured a share of the team trophy in Rochester Institute of Technology's first annual tournament by tying Thiel College, 35-35, in opening its season last weekend.

The Golden Knights had two champions crowned — Bill D'Angelo in the 145-pound class and captain Bob Monks in the 152-pound division. Thiel's Tomcats captured four individual championships.

Monks was voted the tourney's outstanding wrestler. The junior grappler from North Bellmore pinned RIT's Bruce Robinson in the finals.

Other point-getters for Clarkson included: Stan Plato, 130 pounds, second place; Tom Parker, 137 pounds, second place; Pete Wolff, 160 pounds, second place; John Philippi, 177 pounds, second place and Ed Specca, 191 pounds, third place. Four points were awarded for in-

dividual championships; three for second place finishes and third place wrestlers picked up two points.

Clarkson opens its regular season Saturday at 1 p.m. at Alumni Gymnasium against St. Lawrence. The match will mark the first time the two schools have met in the sport on the varsity level.

Clarkson coach Jack Hantz reports that four of his grapplers may miss action because of injuries. Wolff and 167-pounder Steve Sawyer were injured last weekend. Terry McNamara, who wrestles at 130 pounds, and 177-pounder Dan DeRensis, both injured in preseason workouts have been listed as doubtful starters.
