# Edison Grapplers Annex School League Tourney

Edison Tech's well-balanced team, unbeaten Inter-scholastic Wrestling League champions the past two seasons, annexed the city championship tournament last night at West High.

The Inventors placed only two grapplers in the championship round — Emilio DiDataldo in the 157-pound class and Richard Belle in the heavyweight division — but compiled an aggregate score of 87 points.

Madison and Jefferson were runnerups with 65 points apiece. Host West High followed with 49, Franklin 48, Monroe 42, East

25 Marshall 15 and Charlotte 14. In the individual honors, Monroe led as it placed three wrestlers while Jefferson, East, Madison and Edison had two. Franklin and West wound up with one.

Jefferson's Lou Borrelli stole the spotlight when he pinned Gary Demchock of Charlotte in 1:01 to decide the 98-pound class match.

In the quarterfinals, Vorelli downed Dave Coleman of Edison in 40 seconds, he pinned Marshall's Neal Sullivan in 50 seconds in the semifinal round.

Greg Fuller of West and Steve Cangialosi of Jefferson were crowned champions but their victories had to be decided in overtime.

In the 141-pound class, Fuller battled Doug Rhodes to a 2-2 regulation score. In the overtime Fuller applied a reversal to win 2-0. Rhodes was last year's city champ in the 141-pound class and Fuller finished the season undefeated in 11 matches.

The match between Cangialosi and Mario Contreas of Edison ended in a 4-4 deadlock in the 148 weight class. Cangialosi, unbeaten this year in 10 meetings, scored three points in the overtime.

Repeating champions were Carl Oliver of East in the 98-pound class, Tim Whitaker of Monroe in 136 and Charles Belle of Edison in the heavyweight division.

Reggie Wilcox of Madison and Walt Jones of Monroe, last year's runnerups, last night scored victories.

The league had 11 grapplers undefeated this season. Borrelli of Jefferson, DiCataldo of Edison, Fuller of West, Paul McBride of East, Charles Belle of Edison, Walt Jones of Monroe, Whitaker of Monroe and Dave Ferguson of Monroe ended with 11-0 marks.
