

Madison Tops Mat Meet Places 5 on All-Scholastic

Madison placed five grapplers on the All-Scholastic Wrestling Squad and amassed a 91-point total to capture top honors in the Interscholastic Wrestling Tournament at East High last night.

Runnerup West chalked up an 80-point total behind three new city champions while third-place Edison also placed three All-Scholastic matmen en route to a 70-point effort. Other team scores in the nine-squad competition were fourth-place Jefferson with 60, Monroe 40, East 29, Franklin 21, Charlotte 6 and Marshall 6.
