

Livingston-Wyoming Athletic Events in 4 County Merger

President Ted Bondi of the Livingston County Athletic Asso. has announced the merger of the Livingston County Schools with three from Wyoming County and one from Genesee - Orleans. The four teams are Letchworth, Perry and Warsaw of Wyoming and LeRoy of G.O.

League play will start during this winter sports season with classification as follows:

Class A.: Dansville, Wayland, Perry, and LeRoy.

Class B.: Caledonia, Genesee, Livonia, Letchworth and Warsaw.

Class C.: Avon, Mt. Morris, Keshequa, (formerly Nunda and York).

Class D.: Lima.

Football competition among these schools will begin the fall of 1969. Because of the number of football schools, two Divisions have been formed with cross division play for an opening game and cross division play according to standings for final game of the season. The North Division consists of LeRoy, Caledonia, Avon, York, Genesee, and Livonia. The South Division consists of Dansville, Letchworth, Canisteo, Perry, Mt. Morris, and Warsaw.

The soccer league consists of Wayland, Perry, Keshequa (formerly Nunda), Warsaw, and Letchworth.

Schools participating in Wrestling this year are Dansville, Caledonia, Genesee, Mt. Morris, Keshequa, York, Avon, Livonia, LeRoy, Letchworth, Perry, and Warsaw.

Baseball classification remains the same as basketball with Lima a lone "D" school. All county schools will have track teams with the exception of Nunda.

Two year schedules are being drawn up by county sports chairmen. These schedules and classifications will be correlated with Section V classification which is based on a two year Average Daily attendances of boys and girls in grades 9 through 12.
