Coach Don Quinn's East Rochester High School wrestling team continues to remain undefeated in the Monroe County East Division with a 4-0 record after flattening a home Brighton club, 32-11, Friday afternoon.

Winning over Brighton was easy for the Bombers. The club nabbed 9 of the 12 matches, dropping the 140 and 147 pound weight classes and drawing in the 179 pound meet.

The victory started with an 8-0 decision by Jeff Verzella in the opening 100 pound clash. Chris Bourne was a 5-0 winner in the 107 pound test. Then Joe Aloisio nabbed the 114 pound tiff with a 8-3 nod. Armand Marianetti scored a 5-1

decision in the 121 pound division.

The Bombers' strong 126 pounder, Keith Cotroneo, continued undefeated and tallied a pin in 3:50, the only one of the match. Dan Duffy continued ER's winning gait with a 6-0 nod in the 134 pound test. After two lost matches, Billy Schick got the Bombers back on the winning trail with a 157 pound 7-3 decision and Rich McPhee added a 169 pound 6-0 victory.

Steve Rock, previously undefeated for ER, had to go all out to gain a 6-6 tie with Brighton's Tom Reynolds in the 179 pound battle. Joe Marion of the Bombers ended the matches with a 8-1 decision in the heavyweight skirmish.
