



You may notice that this account of the meet is very, very different than the box score which appeared in the December 6 Democrat & Chronicle. Our version was given to us from one of the Edison wrestlers who took it right out of the scorebook. It seems like Edison should have had 49 points, though. The D&C, however, gave the Inventors a 52-12 win which didn't add up even according to the D&C box score version of the results. The D&C account agreed with the Edison scorebook as to who got the forfeits, but the newspaper and scorebook differed on the result (score or time of pin) of literally every other match in the meet. And the differences were substantial in many cases. The D&C said Edison had only a 6-2 decision, not a pin, at 126 for example. This is confusing, folks!




