




Fairport Coach Pete Logan and his wrestlers watch the action in a recent Raider dual meet.







Gates-Chili's Tom Mandara rides out Hilton's Akira Hara en route to 6-2 victory.




Another top performer in the history of Rush-Henrietta wrestling is <u>Hugh Reynolds</u>, who graduated in 1968 after a number of successful varsity seasons with the Comets.

Back then, Section 5 did not enter the State Tournament. If it had, chances are Ralph would have won it all. After graduating. Ralph went on to a fine mat career at Monroe Community College.
