Since we are printing some of Notre Dame's tournament results here, it seems now would be as good a time as any to share with our readers the information Thomas was nice enough to send.

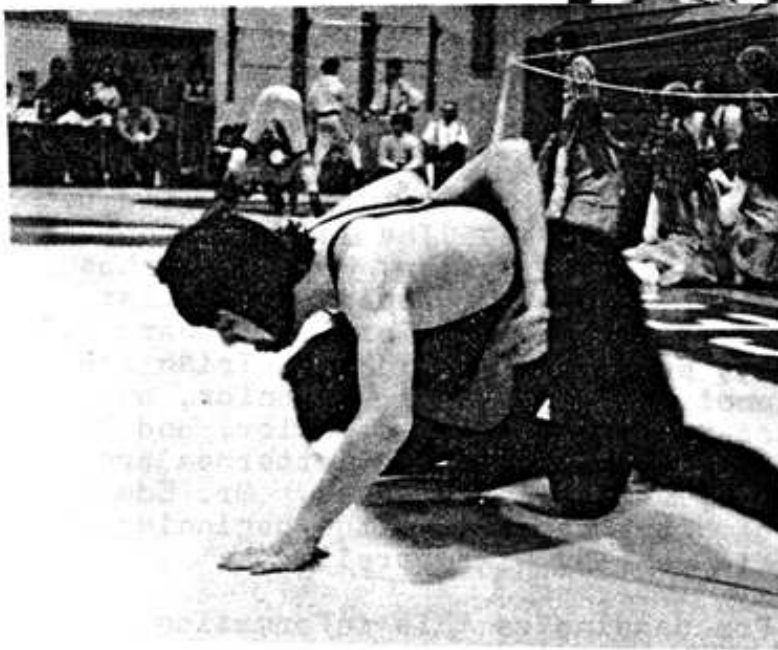
Notre Dame competes in the Monsignor Martin Wrestling League for Catholic schools in the Buffalo diocese. The league is now in its 7th year and for five of the first six years, Notre Dame has won either a regular season or All-Catholic championship. Last year's team won the All-Catholic Tournament at Cardinal O'Hara H.S. in North Tonawanda, scoring 111½ points. The fighting Irish are returning two All-Catholic champions: Roger Rada, a senior, and Mike Hughes, a junior. Runners-up Mike Delong, a senior, and Rick Tresco, a junior, are also back. Other returning lettermen are captain Russ Marchese, Jim Murphy, and Bill Lawrence. Mr. Edward Sullivan has been head coach of Notre Dame since the beginning of the league. He is assisted this year by Mike Strollo.

We thank Thomas Crimando for sending us this information. His knowledge of the school is first hand, as he was the team's manager for three years including last year. And now St. John Fisher is lucky enough to have his services. Below is a picture of him with Fisher coach Mike Cronmiller.

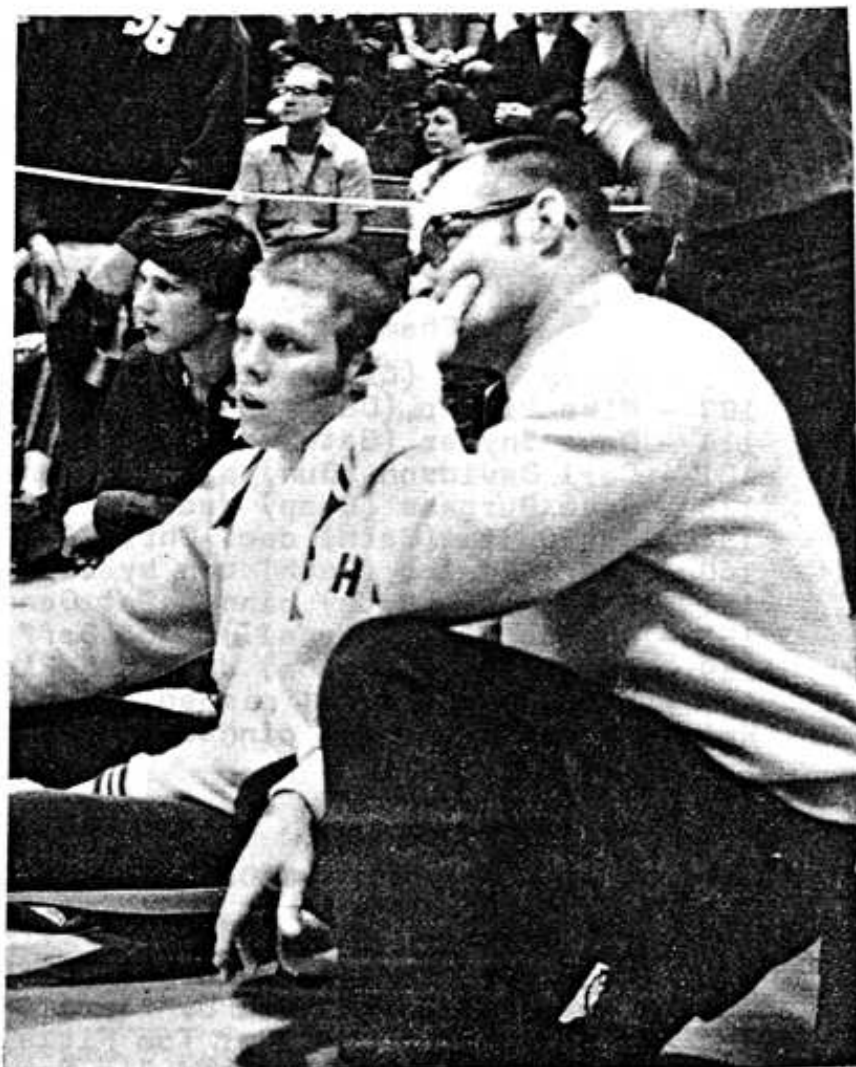

Grapplers at a Glance

ROSS ADRAIN.....a beginning wrestler from Warwick who is learning fast and beginning to find his spot; the freshman should wrestle at 134 pounds.

JAMES ANSPACH.....freshman from Ryersford, Pa., who at 174 is currently wrestling 190-pound class; strong, aggressive and hard worker; last wrestled as a freshman in high school.

GARY BATTISTONE.....freshman from Northport with excellent high school credentials; tough 118-pounder who has already proven his ability. Finished 3-1 in the RIT Invitational and is 1-0 in dual meets to date.

BILL BREEN.....hard worker from Webster. The freshman with limited experience could develop into a strong grappler; also plays soccer for the Tigers.

ADONIS BURRIS.....late comer to the squad after playing football; strong, hard-working freshman from Great Neck who is improving in skills; by mid-season he could help the Tigers.

JOHN FITZPATRICK.....the Olean freshman is an inexperienced heavyweight who grappled in the lower classes in high school; with work will be strong addition.

GREG FULLER.....the senior from Rochester bolsters the Tiger lineup at 150-158; should be his year; the hard worker was runnerup in state and ICAC last year.

JAMES HILL.....will be a strong 167-pounder; the sophomore was relatively inexperienced last year, but has gained confidence and will seek to fill Skip White's shoes, last year's Tiger ace.

JIM HOSSENLOPP.....has been a hard working utility man. The junior from Lockport wrestled from 167 to heavyweight last season. Coach Fuller will be counting on Jim for his dedication and devotion this season.

NORM HUDSON.....slowed by surgery early this season, the sophomore from Troy could push for a varsity spot in the 126-pound class; strong competitor.

GARY HUSTIS.....another ex-football player, the Brewster freshman has limited wrestling experience; will gain needed work on the junior varsity squad.

JAMES JOHNSON.....the freshman from Byron will gain experience and confidence on the junior varsity team; wrestled at Byron-Bergen High School.

PAUL LEVINE.....good high school experience and record; freshman from Tonawanda with strength and desire who will win his share of matches for the Tigers.

CHARLES LEVEY.....utility man who wrestled JV last year; broke into the varsity lineup in upperclass weights last season. The junior from Elmira is expected to see similar duty for Coach Fuller's Tigers.

JIM MILLER.....the senior from Lewiston missed last season. A lacrosse player, he should be tough in the 190 or unlimited division by mid-year.

MATTHEW NOVIELLO.....good high school record; should be pushing for a position in the 150-158 weight class; freshman from Peekskill.

MIKE NOVIELLO.....showed much improvement last year, winning several key matches; never wrestled before coming to RIT. The junior from Peekskill has gained experience and confidence; will be tough in upper weights.

JOHN OMLAND.....ex-footballer from Cobleskill; the freshman, with limited experience, should develop and wrestle in the junior varsity 177-190 matches.

TIM O'NEIL.....the deaf student is a devoted, hard working Tiger. The junior from Hillsborough, Calif., improves each season; strong JV grappler.

GREG PANCIO.....joins the Tigers with good high school wrestling background; freshman from Olean with good attitude and potential for top honors as Tiger.

TOM PEARCE.....outstanding leader; one of this year's co-captains; has wrestled 126 pounds for three years; twice has won the ICAC and state invitationals; looking for another strong season, possibly at 134.

RAY RULIFFSON.....another outstanding wrestler, expected to be top leader again. The co-captain has won the RIT Invitational, State Invitational and ICAC Conference title; was Most Outstanding Wrestler last year in both RIT and state tournaments; very strong grappler.

BOB RUTAN.....a real "horse", says Coach Fuller. Should be tough in his weight class (142); freshman from Spencerport pressing for a varsity spot.

MARK SLOCUM.....always a strong competitor; the sophomore from Woodstock will give the Tigers added depth in the lower weight divisions.

JON TULGA.....transfer from Jamestown Community College; tough competitor in a strong weight division last year, the sophomore from Jamestown will seek top honors at 126.

Iowa State scored 108½ points to beat Oklahoma State (94) for top team honors in the Midland Wrestling Meet at Evanston, Ill., on December 28-29, 1972.

Olympic medal winners John and Ben Peterson won individual honors wrestling unattached. John took the 177 pound championship by beating Mike Bradley of the Michigan Wrestling Club 5-1 while Ben captured the 190 pound title by downing Al Nacin of Iowa State 9-2.

Another Olympic medal winner, Chris Taylor, competed for Iowa State and pinned Tom Hazell of Oklahoma State for the heavyweight title after only 1:42.

Wade Schalles of Clarion State won the 158 pound title by pinning Leo Kocher of Northwestern in 1:17.
