ER-Hilton To Decide

East Rochester and Hilton, who couldn't decide the issue a year ago, will try again to determine the overall county wrestling champion on East-West day tomorrow night at 8 at Hil-

The two teams fought to a controversial 25-25 tie a year ago. This year ER (13-2) comes into the match ranked No. 3 in the state while Hilton (12-1) slipped to No. 12 after last weekend's upset loss to Gates-Chili.

"A few weeks ago, I thought Hilton had the better team," says Coach Pete Logan of Fairport, the only team to face both ER and Hilton this season. "But that was before ER went down and won at Olean and Hilton lost at Gates. Now it's impossible to pick."
