

Blue Devils pin East, Edison



ROCHESTER — The Victor Blue Devils wrestling team raised its overall record to 6-1 as it took on a pair of Rochester schools and beat both in non-league wrestling Saturday.

Victor topped host Edison 44-12 and beat East 55-10.

In doing so, Victor also managed to come away with four wrestlers still unbeaten.

Jeff Annesi won a decision and a forfeit at 126 to keep his record a 6-0-1; Dan Ahonen picked up a pair of pins at 155 to remain unbeaten at 7-0; Scott Lodge, wrestling at 138, scored a pin and a draw putting his record at 5-0-1; and Dale Sadler (167) pinned both of

his opponents to keep his record unblemished at 5-0.

Keith Bonalle (119) and Mark Boehm (177) won both their matches by pins. Ken Halas (105), Mark Flora (132) and Rick Barrett (145) were also double winners.

In Geneva, the Panthers just missed winning their own tournament as Webster Schroeder's Brian Rittenhouse pinned Penn Yan's Andy Olbrecht in 1:54 at 155 to give Schroeder an eight-point lead. Geneva's Lou Cosentino (215) pinned Gates-Chili's C.C. Grant in :50 to cut the final score to Webster 175½, Geneva 173½.

Mike DeRaddo (105), Jeff Principio (126) and Bruce

Hunt (138) were titlists for Geneva. Cosentino had three pins for the tournament in a combined time of 3:08. He is also the first tournament wrestler to win three consecutive titles.
