Holley holds off Attica, wins GR title

HOLLEY — Powerhouse Holley managed to win the Genesee Region League wrestling title Thursday night and stay unbeaten on the season, but Attica gave the Hawks all they could handle.

Holley prevailed 41-37 to improve to 6-0 in league and 20-0 overall.

Attica drops to 5-1 in league and 8-5 overall.

Matt Banks, Matt Sanders and Justin Widrig all won key matches for Holley, which is ranked No. 10 among small schools in the state.

Banks had a reversal with 10 seconds left in his match to earn a 4-2 win over Nick Napierski at 125 pounds for three key points for the Hawks.


Sanders had a takedown with under 10 seconds left and prevailed 10-2 over Jeremy Dominesey at 135.

Widrig sealed the team victory at 140 with a pin over Spencer Ford to put Holley up 41-27.

Ray Feldman's weight class and pin time were in synch as he pinned David Spencer in 1:12 at 112 pounds for Batavia. At 140, Mike Raphael had a 21-6 technical fall in 3:25 over Alexis Ortiz. Raphael is currently 10th alltime in Batavia history with 71 wins. Dylan Goodsell (215) and Kyle Paradise (275) also had pins for Batavia. Nick Lazarony, Troy Ireland, Ryan Darch and Raphael all have won 20plus matches for Batavia this year. Batavia is 3-7.
