
Warsaw pins Caledonia-Mumford, 64-21

Holley victorious over St. Joseph's

CALEDONIA - Five Warsaw wrestlers were victorious via pinfall and the Tigers had little trouble in defeating Caledonia-Mumford 64-21 in a Livingston Conference match Wednesday.

Chris Whiting recorded the quickest pin for Warsaw, taking down Brian Walker in 2:40 at 130 pounds. Phil Mauer was close behind, pinning Jacob MacWilliams in 2:46 at 145.


At 275 pounds, Warsaw's Brandon Mobley-Taylor pinned Tom Gorrow in 3:03, while Dakota Stackhouse needed 3:15 to pin Aaron Wood at 125. Joe Sumeriski outlasted Jon Kemnitz and won by pinfall in 5:44 at 140 pounds.

Nick Czatla of Warsaw recorded a 9major decision over Tim Sullivan at 160 pounds.

Caledonia-Mumford, Nate Anastasi pinned Mike Cummins in 2:51 at 215 pounds and Ben Anastasi defeated David Royce 7-3 at 152.
