At this time I would like to talk about and introduce the 2006-2007 Varsity Wrestling team:

---

This year's squad finished the year with 19 wrestlers on JV and Varsity. At the end of the season, the Warriors finished in 1<sup>st</sup> place and repeated as champions of the ECIC Division II finishing 8-0 and 12-2 overall. The only losses were to Spencerport who was #1 in NYS and Niagara Wheatfield who was #1 in WNY. The Warriors placed 1<sup>st</sup> at the Class AAA Tournament placing a staggering 13 of 14 wrestlers and sending 9 to the Sectionals Tournament in Fredonia. Out of the 9 wrestlers, 4 placed in the top 4 and we sent another wrestler to the state tournament which was Jared Messina at 119 lbs. The Warriors also won the prestigious ECIC Tournament. The Warriors finished the season ranked #2 in WNY Large schools and #26 in NYS. The Warriors seen two wrestlers compile over 100 wins in their short varsity career with 2 years still left Jared Messina and Clay Reeb. In three seasons together now, we have graduated only 4 wrestlers. These wrestlers that I will soon mention have gone from admiring the rest of Section 6 to being one of the top teams that coaches strive to have and wrestlers strive to be.

Where do we go from here? As this team strives for more, we must understand that weight lifting is vital to getting to the next level as well as the following two things: 1) getting more wrestlers out for this team and 2) understanding where they want to wrestle next season. Rules on weight loss are getting tougher and stricter. The team in front of me is getting tougher and tougher. With that said, not being at the right weight for next season could keep you out of the lineup. Not having a JV team that is young and willing to learn will not keep this program going forward.

If you look at the records in the Banquet booklet you will find the numbers getting tougher and tougher to get your name on a list. What a pleasure as a coach seeing wrestlers striving to leave their legacy behind!

I would also like to bring up this last point and end speculations of what happened and who said what. At the end of the season we had a wrestler get involved with an altercation with a wrestler from Niagara Wheatfield. To make a huge story short after the administration and I attended a Section 6 hearing with Niagara Wheatfield, the bottom line is it is very important for the wrestlers to stay together, the parents to be supportive of their kids and to make sure we do not get involved with any opposing teams in a negative way. This is a sport of much emotion. Like the Section 6 committee said, "a brother came in defense of his brother and a son came in defense of his father. As adults, we must refrain from saying anything to wrestlers but in the same sense a wrestler has no right talking back to an adult in a negative way. This incident should now be closed and this team should be moving forward to any great things ahead! I also encourage all wrestlers to please stay off the Section 6 web site that is full of who said what and how and not substantiated by truth.
