We spoke in the past about ROC E6 and our mission to bring lacrosse and wrestling to inner city student-athletes in order to create hope for a successful future in students who do not naturally believe in it. *Hope* will eventually deter them from negative behaviors. Even more important than the sports, the student-athletes eat breakfast and lunch daily! In addition to all this, the students will be taking final exams in Math and ELA soon!

The camp is going great in every aspect except funding. It seems I have finally bitten off more than I can chew....
